- 1. Enclose the true copy of annual sports fees registration receipt year 2018-2019
- 2. Team Managers and the Participants will be picked up from the Bus stand. Please furnish the accurate information in the enclosed format.
- 3. Team Managers have to report at the Registration Counter for Registration as soon as they reach the venue.
- 4. Team Managers have to collect the Tournament programme, Room Nos. from the Registration Counter immediately after their arrival.
- 5. The school expects the Team to maintain discipline in the school premises.
- 6. No objection certificate has to be obtained, after handing over the charge of room to the "Respective In charge" on duty for the issuances of departure slip.
- 7. Any type of breakage or loss to the school property will be charged from the concerned school for which Rs. 2000/- will be taken as caution deposit. This will be refunded at the time of departure.
- 8. The boarding amount payable by the participants and team manager for three days as per the directive of CBSE.
- 9. It is compulsory for all the participant teams to attend opening and closing ceremony of Cluster VIII Volleyball Tournament 2018-19.
- 10. All team managers and coaches meeting will be on7-10-2018 at 7.30 pm.

AGE CRITERION:

As specified by the rules and regulations of the CBSE sports

committee. MANDATORY

- 1) To supply the photograph of individual team member along with the entry form, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- 2) The student / player studying in class IX and above to provide CBSE registration number given in class IX.
- 3) Any team / player not fulfilling the above requirement before the commencement of the tournament shall not be permitted to participate.
- 4) CBSE participate ID Cards.

RULES OF VOLLEYBALL

- 1. The rules as adopted by the Volleyball Federation of India shall be followed, with modifications wherever applicable.
- 2. A team shall Consists of Maximum 12 players.
- 3. At Cluster level, all the matches shall be played on knock out basis.
- 4. The matches at Cluster level shall be played as **best of three sets, each set of 25 points**. A set is won by the team which first scores 25 points with a minimum lead of two points. In the case of a 24-24 tie, play is continued until a two point lead is achieved (26-24; 27-25;)
- 5. The semi final and final, will be played as best of five sets. In case of a two two sets tie, the deciding set (fifth set) will be played to 15 points until a two point lead is achieved (16-14; 17-15;)
- 6. Maximum **two time** outs per set, of **30** seconds each will be allowed on the request of concerned coach/captain.
- 7. The colour and design of the playing kit of the members of team must be the same, except for **"libero"** (defensive player) who must wear a uniform contrast in colour with that of the other members of the team.
- 8. The **first position** winning teams from every Cluster will qualify to participate in National level tournament.
- 9. Ordinarily, no team shall be called upon to play two matches a day. In exceptional circumstances, however if a team is asked to play two matches a day, there should be at least a gap of four hours between the two matches.
- 10. All the teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school Principal.
- 11. No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official and no player is permitted to go out of campus without prior permission.
- 12. No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letterhead.
- 13. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
- 14. In case of Girls participants, one of the accompanying officials must be a female.
- 15. Incomplete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
- 16. Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules.

- 17. Medical check up may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the cases of overage suspicion.
- 18. A player shall be under 17; & 19 years of age as on 31 Dec of the year of event.

Accordingly, for session 2018-19 sports events, the age criteria will be as follows:

19. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2002

20. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2000

21. All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

- 22. A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons.
- 23. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
- 24. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
- 25. Misbehaviour on ground by athlete or accompanying official.
- 26. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
- 27. Misbehaviour with Officials/Opponents by athlete or accompanying official.
- 28. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official.
- 29. Damaging the school property.
- 30. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by athlete or accompanying official.

PROTEST

- 31. Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within one hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand).
- 32. The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding.

(The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing Nationals along with the original entry Performa.)

33. Safety & Security of the team members is the sole responsibility of the concerned team manager.
